ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Addis Ababa – The New Flower Founded in 1886 by Menelik II, Addis Ababa (“The New Flower”) is Ethiopia’s capital and one of the world’s fastest-growing cities. At 2,400m above sea level, it is the third-highest capital worldwide, with a pleasant year-round climate averaging 25°C.

Highlights of our city tour include the National Museum with Lucy, the 3.5-million-year-old hominid; Merkato, Africa’s largest open-air market; and an authentic Ethiopian coffee ceremony.



SCHEDULE -01 - MOUNT ENTOTO ,EMPEROR MENELIK PLACE

Mountain Entoto the Highest peak in Addis Ababa altitude of 2400 above sea level and the perfect place of to see the full panoramic view of the city at Entoto we also visit the very historical Emperor Minilek palace , the palace built by Emperor Menelik (Minilik) is owned by Ethiopian orthodox (Tewahedo)St. Mary church Entoto kidist Mariam church). Here we will visit the palace and museum.



SCHEDULE -02 NATIONAL MUSEUM OF ETHIOPIA.

The museum showcases Ethiopia's artistic treasures and priceless archaeological finds, including Lucy, the 3.2-million-year-old *Australopithecus afarensis*, and Selam, a 3.3-million-year-old child fossil. Exhibits span ancient and medieval artifacts, royal regalia, and Ethiopian art from the 14th–20th centuries, offering a vivid overview of the nation's cultural richness.



SCHEDULE -03 - VISIT ADWA VICTORY MEMORIAL MUSEUM.

Explore the Adwa Victory Memorial Museum and discover the history and significance of Ethiopia's historic victory at the Battle of Adwa. Learn about the leaders, events, and legacy of this landmark moment in Ethiopian history.





SCHEDULE- -04 MERCATO THE LARGEST OPEN AIR MARKET IN AFRICA

Merkato is the largest open Air market in Africa and It takes heart to venture into the chaotic-looking, sprawling marketplace of Addis Ababa, but despite what it may seem at first glance, the market is very much organized, subdivided into "quarters" dedicated to a specific kind of wares. Your guide will help you navigate; many vendors keep goods inside permanent stalls, so what is being sold might not be apparent at first glance. Items worth browsing for are leather goods, silver jewelry, spices, and many more.



SCHEDULE- -05 VISIT THE AFRICAN UNION HEADQUARTERS

Visit the African Union Headquarters in Addis Ababa, the diplomatic heart of the continent and an important symbol of African unity. Learn about the African Union's role in promoting peace, security, development, and cooperation among member states while exploring this significant landmark of modern Africa.
